Add to that 400 species of birds and countless fascinating critters of nature, like dung beetles and termites, and you start to appreciate just how much more there is to see and learn than your bucket list Big 5.



In our week-long Tasimba experience, we have the time to sit in our vehicles, at the hides or on the deck in camp and just watch. We may see an elephant family playing at the waterhole, zebra grazing on the endless plains, lions panting in the hot sun under the leafy branches of an acacia tree or baboon juveniles wrestling each other off a termite mound.

This is the Tasimba way: we slow down, take time, <u>see more</u>, hear more – and are more amazed!
